Metal Roofing Frequently Asked Questions

Will the amount noise increase in my home with a metal roof?

Metal roofs in residential applications are installed over solid roof decking, similar to asphalt shingles. This eliminates the undesirable noise which occurs when metal roofing is installed without a substrate.

Will a metal roof make me more susceptible to lightning strikes?

A metal roof will not make a building more susceptible to a lightning strike. Lightning will tend to strike the highest object in a given area, regardless of what that object is made of. A metal roof can actually be beneficial in the event of a lightning strike due to the fact that it is a non-combustible material.

Will my roof rust?

Corrosion resistant substrates and long-life finishes ensure long-term performance, minimal maintenance and life-cycle cost savings.

Will a metal roof cost more than traditional shingles?

Because metal roofing is a premium home product, you can expect your new roof to cost two to three times more than what an asphalt shingle roof costs. However, a metal roof is comparable in price to tile roofing, or cedar shake roofing. If you currently have a slate roof, you can expect your metal roof to cost less.
